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What is the capacity of WtE power plant in Dhaka?

The power plant will be constructed with an installed (gross) capacity of 42.5 MW. In 2012, the Power Division signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Management Environment Finance, an Italian company, to set up a WTE power plant in Dhaka (Bangla Tribune 2021).

Who sponsors WtE power plant north Dhaka?

The power plant is sponsored by WTE Power Plant North Dhaka Private Limited, a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) of the CMEC. CMEC is a subsidiary of China National Machinery Industry Corporation (Sinomach), which is a state-owned enterprise (SOE) in China.

Did Bangladesh cancel all coal plants in 2020?
