You will probably still have an electric utility bill after going solar. Most homeowners need power from the grid at night and when their panels aren't producing enough electricity. The average monthly residential electric bill is \$136.84 for 855 kilowatt hours, according to the Department of Energy

Will my utility bill change after installing solar?

Your rate plan may change post-installation as required by your utility provider. Solar can greatly reduce your electric bill, but you will often still have a residual bill. The size of your utility bill depends on many factors including local utility rates, the size of your system relative to your energy needs and what time of day you use energy.

What will be on my bill if my solar panels don't work?

Usually, the following items will be on your bill: Electricity Usage Charges: You will still need to buy some electricity from the grid if your solar panels don't generate enough to meet all of your energy needs. Grid Connection Fees: Regardless of how much power you use, utilities often charge an annual cost to stay connected to the grid.

Can I reduce my electric bill if I go solar?

Ideally, you'll be able to eliminate your electric bill charges after going solar. You may even see some negative bills if you can carry over net metering credits month-to-month. But, as we've explained, this might not be possible if you don't have a great net metering policy, or if you can't install a large enough solar panel system.
